



Of special interest...

- ❶ **Pont du Pontet**, built in 1680-1681 and renovated in Autumn 1993, thanks to the Ecu d'Or and IVS organisations. It is the former strategic crossing of the path for the mules and their drivers to the Jaman pass.
- ❷ **The Basses-Sciernes tilted bridge**, erected in 1580, in the medieval style.
- ❸ **The covered bridge** between Montbovon and Les-soc. Built in 1667, it is the most ancient of this type in the canton of Fribourg. It was renovated in 1722 and 1767. The shingle-covered roof has been frequently restored, the last time in 1995.
- ❹ **Church**. Built as from June 1896, it was consecrated on May 24th 1898: the bell-tower was repaired in 1992 and the inside of the church was restored in 1997.
- ❺ **Chapel of La Gaulaz**, dedicated to Our Lady of the Peace. Consecrated on May 31st 1942, it was a mark of gratitude for having been preserved from the terrible calamity of war.
- ❻ **Vieux Chalet**. It was the former White Cross Inn, a posting-house at the time of stage-coaches. It was built in 1725 and classified a historical monument in 1995.
- ❼ **Chapelle d'Allières**. The old chapel, dedicated to Saint Mary-Magdalen and consecrated on July 27th 1721, was swept away by a landslide on February 14th 1990. Building of the new chapel was completed in 1995.

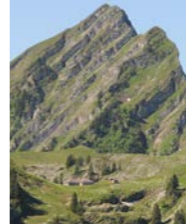

Nestled at the foot of the Dent de Corjon, Montbovon is situated between the mountain ranges of the Dent de Lys and the Vanil Noir. On its right, at the bottom of the valley, you can hear the sound of the Sarine river, and on its left the river Hongrin comes tumbling down.

This charming village borders five Communes in the Canton of Vaud: Rossinière, Montreux, Villeneuve, Veytaux and Blonay.

Following the merger of Communes, Montbovon is now part of the Haut Intyamon Commune.

It is an important train junction which serves two railway companies: the MOB, which links Montreux to Zweisimmen, and the TPF to Bulle and Fribourg; it has one train station and three stops on its territory.

This gives you an alternative between public transport and hiking, as Montbovon offers around 180 km of hiking trails for a vast variety of walks, from the most accessible to the more demanding, all with exceptional views.

Some special events: guided walks, Bénichon (Swiss equivalent of Thanksgiving) Mid-summer festival, Open-bike mountain bike race, etc.

Here are 14 proposals of walking trails

Starting from Montbovon train station:

- 1. Walk round the Lessoc lake, via Le Commun (1 h 30) or via Bellegarde (1 h 15).

- 2. Loop of the Chia, via Vers les Pichon, Grosse Chia, Usine électrique (1 h 30).
- 3. Loop of the Cuvigne, via Plan au Lièvre, Les Raves, Pra du Pont, Les Raves, Plan au Lièvre (2 h 15).

- 9. Historical path of the col de Jaman: Montbovon - Allières via the Pontet bridge, Les Cases, col de Jaman (3 h 15).

Perchia, Les Verreaux, col de Jaman, Les Cases, Allières (4 h 30 ou 4 h).

- 10. Sentier des Earls' path: Montbovon - Gruyères, with various places of interest (5 h 45).

- 14. Allières - col de Bonaudon, Buvette de Jaman via the Hongrin valley and the Bonaudon dale (4 h 30).

- 11. Sentier Agro-sylvicole: Walk from Montbovon to Estavannens, with several explanatory signs regarding agricultural life (4 h).



Alternative via the Grotte du Glacier - Rochers de Naye: before the col de Bonaudon, take a left until the cave's entrance (1h 15 from the cave). Outside alternative also possible.

- 4. Loop of La Brâ, via Grosse Chia, Petite Chia, Sonlomot, La Brâ, Les Cerniettes, Plains-Bu (4 h).

- 5. Montbovon - Les Sciernes d'Albeuve - Allières, via Turquibaud (2 h 10).

- 6. Montbovon - Les Sciernes d'Albeuve - Les Cases, via Turquibaud, Aveneyre, Le Gournay (3 h 15) or Le Gournay - col de Jaman (3 h 35).

- 7. Montbovon - Allières via La Cuvigne and Les Mosses (2 h 50).

- 8. Montbovon - Rossinière via La Brâ (5 h).

Starting from Allières train station:

- 12. Loop of the Urqui photograph exhibition/and the Fauna and Flora itinerary via Orgevaux, l'Urqui, Joux des Heures, Combe d'Allières, Chaux d'Avau (4 h).

- 13. Loop of the Verreaux via Orgevaux, l'Urqui (or Combe d'Allières, Joux des Heures), col de Pierra

CAUTION!
This is a difficult alpine itinerary, open from July 15th. To go through the cave, it is imperative to have a torch per person and good hiking shoes.
